

Online Entry Guidelines

These guidelines are designed to ensure that you are successful in entering World Snooker events through the Online Entry Portal.

1. METHODS OF ENTRY:

You can enter any World Snooker Main Tour event using the following website www.wsplayers.com
Please note that this is the only method we will accept for entering an event subject to points 3 and 4 below.

2. ENTRY DEADLINE

The closing date and time of the Entry Deadline is clearly marked on the entry pack for each event. Entries will not be accepted after the Entry Deadline has passed. It is advised that you enter any event that you wish to compete in at the earliest available opportunity to avoid missing the Entry Deadline.

3. TECHNICAL ISSUES AND EXTENSIONS TO THE ENTRY DEADLINE.

Should technical issues with the online entry portal prevent you from entering an event you must immediately notify the World Snooker office on 0117 317 8200.

Only if it can be demonstrated that a player has experienced technical difficulties which prohibited him/her from entering an event prior to the Entry Deadline will World Snooker consider taking payment from another source.

World Snooker will only consider a request to extend the Entry Deadline where (i) WSL was notified prior to the Entry Deadline lapsing and (ii) World Snooker was unable to rectify the fault prior to the Entry Deadline.

If World Snooker do extend a closing date all players will be notified by World Snooker that the Entry Deadline has been extended.

4. ENTRY FEES FROM PRIZE MONEY DUE TO A PLAYER FROM WORLD SNOOKER

If a player is due prize money from World Snooker Limited a player can elect to deduct their entry fee from prize money due to them.

This facility will not be available in relation to events where players are paid directly by the promoter (i.e. the majority of overseas events).

Should a player wish to pay their entry fees using prize money held by World Snooker Limited, the player should email Simon Brownell at simon.brownell@worldsnooker.com before the Entry Deadline for the relevant event.

Within the email the player must:

- a. confirm that the player understands the terms and conditions of entry to the event they are entering; and
- b. state that it is the players' intention to pay the Entry fee from Prize Money due.
